

Research Stays abroad for doctoral students of CRC 1333

The CRC 1333 funds project-related research stays abroad for a maximum length of 3 months for doctoral researchers of CRC 1333 and associated CRC doctoral researchers.

How does it work?

- Find a short research project/skill thematically related to the CRC and that you can best do/ learn in a research laboratory abroad
 - Talk to your supervisor/ PI
 - Find a host professor
- Hand in a maximum 1 page proposal to the CRC board including the length of your planned stay and an estimate for the required funding for travel and accommodation
- The CRC board will decide in its regular meetings which proposals will be funded.
- After the research stay the doctoral researcher must report about it in a presentation during the CRC Summer School.

Please note:

- The CRC only funds travel costs and accommodation (same as “Dienstreise”, but no “Tagegeld” will be covered!)
- Doctoral students whose position is not financed by the CRC 1333 for the whole period of their doctoral research or at all, please talk to the CRC office in advance to see whether funding is possible at all.
